What is Forestry Certification?

Forestry Certification is a voluntary, market mechanism design to improve forest management globally. The idea behind it is that consumers will select products that come from well managed forests in preference to products from badly managed forests.

What is Chain of Custody?

Chain of Custody, or COC, Certification provides independent evidence that forest products originate from well managed forests.

It helps consumers, house builders, businesses and government departments make informed decisions about the timber they buy.

Why have COC Certification?

In the UK, COC certification is becoming an industry standard for companies.

- Central Government and private development projects require it
- Increasing numbers of local authority contracts require it
- Many large companies are increasingly buying certified forest products
- Companies can use the trademarks to promote themselves as having sustainable timbers

What is FSC

The Forest Stewardship Council (FSC) is an international network designed to promote responsible management of the world's forests.

Finally FSC come once a year to audit the company, checking to see whether we are managing COC correctly keeping records of purchases and sales and using logos in accordance with scheme rules.
